NO SURF FISHING!!


Wade fishing is allowed within sight of Boat! THIS IS A BAY FISHING TOURNAMENT

another person to your boat.

All Texas Parks & Wildlife Dept. Rules will be enforced. All fish must be caught on a rod and reel no gigging or spearing. Participants MUST fish from the boat they are registered on (Switching boats at any time during the tournament is NOT allowed).

****ALL FISH MUST BE CAUGHT ON ROD AND REEL ****

1. All Federal and state rules and regulations will apply: VIOLATION(S) WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION!

- 2. BLACKJACK for this tournament is 3 Red fish that measures no more than 21" or closest to 21" but not over, the best score possible is a total of 63"
 - (Ex.- Red 21", Red 21", & Red 21" = 63" Total)
- 3. This contest is per boat. Entry is \$100.00 and will cover all Individuals registered on the boat. The payout will be 50 / 50
- 4. You will only be able to present 3 fish per boat, which will be measured. (If you commit an error or present the wrong fish you will not be able to replace with another fish)
- 5. Fish must be presented at weigh-in between 2pm -4:30pm (MUST BE IN LINE BEFORE 4:30PM)
- 6. IN CASE OF A TIE, WINNINGS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED EQUALLY!
- 7. All participants will be subject to polygraph testing, if necessary!
- 8. All Weigh-in Master rulings are final.
- 9. No fish may be accepted or given to another angler or boat.
